The ongoing congestion issues at Port Botany terminal is causing concern for major businesses.

The Australian Trucking Association advised delays had peaked at about three to four hours long, with a truck rank swelled to between 3km and 4km, stretching down Botany and Bunnerong Road and into neighbouring Matraville. Sydney Ports advised issues like congestion were still being dealt with.
